

The Homeland Security Management Institute (HSMI) of Monroe Community College is offering a seminar entitled "Active Shooter Intermediate".

This course consist of a tabletop exercise and focuses on the response phase of an active shooter incident. It is intended to test emergency response capabilities; develop and build working relationships needed during such an incident; and rehearse agency responsibilities. The exercise will be led by a facilitator and will place participants to role play in a scenario-based exercise. This course is intended to help identify physical, psychological and financial aspects and define staff roles and responsibilities.

This course is intended for supervisors or staff who may be tasked with decision making, creating policy, first responders, security, building managers, administrators. Participants should be familiar with their agencies emergency response plan and be able to apply it during the exercise.

It is highly recommended that the participants have completed the "Active Shooter Awareness" course as a pre-requisite.
