- Training must address regional HEPC training gaps and needs
- Funds cannot be used to supplant costs for training or professional certifications that is a condition of employment.
- Training activities may include but are not limited to: initial education, continuing education, appropriate certifications, and just-in-time training.
- Conferences will be evaluated on an individual basis and should be:
 - A training or workshop;
 - Topics and materials addressed should be specifically relevant and applicable to New York, i.e., lessons learned, case scenarios; and
 - Address ASPR Healthcare Preparedness & Response Capabilities.
- The request to add an additional training to the list must be submitted by a HEPC Lead to the OHEP Preparedness Training Manager
 - Request to add an additional training must include justification that should address:
 - Name of training
 - Description of training
 - Regional HEPC training gap/need
 - Target audience
