In the end it all comes down to the local plan, but if ever needed there can be coordination with other partners to expand as needed. The containers and where they are stored can not be split up for security and tracking purposes. There are regulations in place for reporting high attendance events. We don't get involved in that part (I think it goes though BEMS). Most high attendance events have no need for additional CHEMPACK resources, if there was an event that had a credible threat or need for the assets the county and regional NYSDOH staff would be having discussions and a request for the special events container can be made. However a full plan for using the assets must be in place, responding to the event, and safety and security for the container all come			
		into play. The special events containers being deployed happens very rarely, but if there is a need and the conditions are met we will
