



National Incident Management System (NIMS) Refresh Update (LHD BPR 5 / HPP Deliverable 3)

Background

In October, 2017, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) updated NIMS information. The updated version:

- Retains key concepts from 2004 and 2008 versions
- Reflects and incorporates policy updates
- Clarifies processes and terminology for qualifying, certifying, and credentialing incident personnel
- Clarifies that NIMS is more than just the Incident
- Command System (ICS), and that it applies to all incident personnel
- Explains the relationship among the ICS,
- Emergency Operations Center (EOC), and senior leaders/policy groups
- Describes the functions and terminology for staff in EOCs

Goal

The goals of the Informational Session are to ensure that local preparedness partners:

- Have the most current information about NIMS;
- Can identify the appropriate training needed; and
- Incorporate the revised NIMS concepts into emergency preparedness planning, training, and exercises.
