Description:

The primary audience of this class will be for those participating in the WRECKIT exercise. This two day course will be focused on the partnership and coordination between the National Weather Service, NWS and emergency managers. The goal is to enhance the ability to recognize potentially hazardous weather and flooding situations and coordinate an effective response to these weather events. Participants will determine their community's vulnerability to identified hazards and how to interpret National Weather Service information products.
