Description:

This course will prepare participants to engage individuals and volunteer organizations through social media, especially in the context of disaster preparedness and response. Social media engagement is often an enigma to most people, particularly in the public sector, because it is a different form of communication than most are accustomed. Through this course, participants will learn how to develop content that engages their audiences and turns their words into action throughout the disaster cycle. Participants will learn about social media engagement techniques, individual and organizational roles in crisis communication and Virtual Operations Support Teams (VOST).

Who Should Attend?

Public and private sector organizations with the responsibility to convey disaster related information to the public as well as gather information during and after a disaster. This might include the following members or representatives of the following groups: State, county and local emergency management agencies. In addition, it may include Community Emergency and Community Response Teams such as neighborhood organizations, community associations and various non-first responder response teams.

- **Participants will be required to bring their own laptop or wi-fi enabled device to the training session for the hands-on exercises. This course conducts a Pre-test, Post-test, and Course Evaluation online.**
