What is CEPA?

- CEPA is a framework and tool to help State and local stakeholders assess risk, capabilities, and the potential need for support and resources during emergencies or disasters.
- CEPA provides for a **standardized and repeatable** process to understand capabilities at the County level and identify statewide trends.
- The key component of CEPA is an in-person meeting between State and local subject matter experts to discuss and analyze local hazard and capability information and potential resource gaps.

- *** Conducted/ coordinated with Local Health Department Deliverable Exercise**
 - If this deliverable is selected, each hospital will be expected to participate with other partners in planning this full-scale exercise, as well as evaluate the exercise at the hospital. A hospital module with the same scenario as the medical countermeasures dispensing exercise will be developed by OHEP and provided to hospitals for incorporation into the LHD dispensing exercise.
