Through the Assistance to Firefighter Grant Program, the DC Firefighters Burn Foundation has been able to develop a burn injury awareness program for firefighters nationwide. - Pre-hospital treatment of a burn injury
- Treatment and rehabilitation process following a burn injury
- Building a partnership with your local burn unit
