INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM - NATIONAL TRAINING CURRICULUM

Course Description:

This course is designed to provide emergency responders with an understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Safety Officer on an Incident Management Team

Course Background:

The primary goal of the NIMS ICS All-Hazards Position Specific Training Courses is to provide all-hazards competencies and behaviors for Command and General Staff and selected Unit Leader personnel who are members of an existing or developing Incident Management Team (IMT). Competencies in the training are focused around the ability of the student to assume specific position responsibilities, lead assigned personnel, communicate effectively, and to ensure the completion of assigned tasks in order to meet identified objectives for the position. Personal qualifications to serve as members of IMTs are designed to consider a combination of training, operational experience during exercises or actual incidents, job shadowing, field mentoring, and administrative requirements.

Who Should Attend?

Persons currently or likely to assume the role of the Safety Officer or Assistant Safety Officer on an Incident Management Team.

To ensure the most appropriate target audience for this course, SOEM will review all registrations prior to acceptance to the course.

Completion:

Participants, who actively participate in the course, attend all course contact hours and pass a written final exam will receive a FEMA Emergency Management Institute (EMI) Certificate of Completion.
