Referrals to GI and Hepatology involve ongoing collaboration with primary care providers. The latest treatments, guidelines and recommendations in various topics, such as: *Helicobacter pylori* treatment, screening colonoscopy, cirrhosis, obesity, liver transplant, pancreatic cysts and more will be discussed to develop quality and cost effective strategies for successful patient outcomes in 2017 and beyond.

At the conclusion of this program, participants should be able to:

- Discuss the updates on *Helicobacter pylori* treatment.
- Understand the steps in evaluation of the patient with chronic constipation.
- Describe fecal microbiota transplant and its indications.

- Develop improved understanding of the complex endoscopic interventions and management in various GI conditions.
