Women's Initiative Supporting Health (WISH) Transitions Clinic



What is Women's Initiative Supporting Health Transitions Clinic (WISH)?

WISH serves women who were recently released from jail or prison, or are otherwise involved in the criminal legal system.

What do WISH services include?

- Community Health Care Workers to help women access healthcare and community services
- Guidance for women involved in the criminal legal system in taking charge of their health.
- Meetings with Community Health Care Workers
- Primary care physician/PCP to provide prescriptions and referrals where needed
- Bus passes provided at the clinic
- Mental Health referrals and psychiatric medications
- Substance use disorder treatment integrated with the resources at Strong Memorial Hospital
- We can get medical appointments scheduled before release

Please note: Women will not receive services until after release. Our goal is to identify eligible women before their release or as soon after release as possible. The sooner we link them to services, the better chance they have of successful re-entry.

- We can help women have their medical records sent to us before their release. This will allow us to better understand their medical needs when they arrive at the clinic.

Please note that all services are provided in a timely and confidential manner.

Who is eligible for WISH?

Women 18 years and older who are involved in the criminal legal system, including those recently released from jail or prison. If you do not have health insurance, we will help you link to Medicaid or Strong Charity Care, if you are eligible.

Where are WISH services provided?

Patients will receive medical care at the University of Rochester Medicine in Psychiatry Service (MIPS). MIPS has a long history of caring for people who have medical and mental healthcare needs. Our site has a pharmacy and lab.
