THE CLINICAL AND TRANSLATIONAL SCIENCE BUILDING

On October 27, 2008, Dr. Thomas Pearson, Program Director of NCDHR, along with other University of Rochester officials and New York State legislators, broke ground for the new Clinical & Translational Science Building (CTSB). The new building will be a \$76 million, 4-story, 200,000 square foot facility. Slated for completion in Summer 2010, the CTSB will be

the permanent home of several important research programs, including NCDHR.

Several New York State legislators, as well as Dr. Pearson, spoke briefly during the event. Multiple photos were taken of the figureheads breaking ground to kick off the long awaited construction.



The new CTSB will allow multiple disciplines to collaborate and work in closer proximity to one another.
