TREATING TOBACCO USE DISORDER IN BEHAVIORAL HEALTH POPULATIONS

BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SURVEY (BRFSS) REPORT HIGHLIGHTS SMOKING RATES IN NEW YORK STATE

- Adult smoking in 2019 was 12.7%, down 10.6% since 2016.
- Rates remain highest among those with mental distress (24.7%); those on Medicaid (22.9%); unemployed (21.4%); living with disability (19.7%); and incomes < \$25,000 (17.9%).
- The smoking rate among young adults (18-24) has reached a new low of 7.6%; however vaping remains high among this age group.

NYS Quitline Referrals

Quitline referrals for our 11 counties from January - March 2022 totaled 1,875 followed by 38 referrals from December- April 2022 totaling 1,913 referrals.
