OVERVIEW

Our part-time, 35-credit Clinical Nurse Leader program prepares experienced nurses with a bachelor's in nursing to address increasing expectations for high-quality, highvalue health care by influencing the way health care is delivered. The University of Rochester School of Nursing was one of the first institutions to offer a master's degree aligned with the CNL certification, and we are the only CNL program in Upstate NY. Graduates may be eligible to sit for national certification.

OTHER PROGRAM OPTIONS Post-Master's Certificate program and CNL-Doctor of Nursing Practice program provide credit efficiencies to nurses interested in practicing at the highest levels of leadership and clinical scholarship in health care systems.

CURRICULUM


The Clinical Nurse Leader program offers a flexible hybrid-online curriculum, in which students will:

- collaborate with nurses and other health professionals who work at the complex intersection of clinical care, population health, and health care systems to focus on safety and quality
- build on previous clinical nursing knowledge and work experience, with coursework focused on nursing leadership, clinical practice, interprofessional team-based care, and clinical outcomes management
- complete coursework online, with some classroom time in the evenings for in-person support to accommodate full-time work schedules

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- a bachelor's degree in nursing from an accredited school
- RN licensure within the United States or a U.S. territory
- a minimum of three years of employment as a RN in a clinical setting preferred
- CPR certification
- statistics course with a grade of C or above (Our online statistics course can be completed in just 4 to 15 weeks)
- graduate-level writing course (may be taken as a non-matriculated course: NUR 401 – Writing Workshop course)
- undergraduate physical assessment course within the last 5 years or NSG 363 – Comprehensive Health Assessment Refresher (may be taken as a non-matriculated course). Required before registering for NLX 422.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis with the opportunity to enroll in fall, spring, or summer semesters. Program prerequisites and selected program courses may also be taken as a non-matriculated student.

ADMISSION CHECKLIST

To apply to the Clinical Nurse Leader program, applicants will need to submit the following:

- official transcripts from all schools attended, including prerequisites (cumulative GPA of 3.0 preferred)
- ☐ resume or CV
- professional goal statement
- □ written clinical case example
- ☐ writing sample (academic paper, clinical document, or publication)
- ☐ two letters of reference
- for international students, TOEFL with a minimum score of 560 (paper-based), 230 (computer-based) or 88 (iBT)
