OVERVIEW

This part-time, 30-credit master's program is designed for the working healthcare professional interested in developing leadership skills as an administrator, nurse leader or healthcare manager. Learn best practices for leading teams to ensure high-quality patient outcomes. Graduates may be eligible to sit for national certification in Nursing Management and Leadership, and National Healthcare Leadership.

GREs or other standardized tests not required to apply.

CURRICULUM

The Healthcare Organization Management and Leadership program offers a flexible curriculum, in which students will:

- Sharpen skills as a manager or leader and learn best practices to assure efficient, quality and safe patient care delivery systems
- Take coursework in human resource management, performance improvement, healthcare finance, population health, program design, program evaluation and organizational leadership
- Complete coursework online, with some classroom time in the evenings for in-person support, to accommodate full-time work schedules

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited school
- Statistics course with a grade of C or above (our *online, self-paced statistics course* can be completed in as little as four weeks)
- Graduate-level writing course (may be taken as a non-matriculated course with NUR 401 – Writing Workshop course)

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis with the opportunity to enroll in fall, spring or summer semesters. Program prerequisites and selected program courses may also be taken as a non-matriculated student.

ADMISSION CHECKLIST

To apply to the Healthcare Organization Management and Leadership program, applicants will need to submit the following:

- official transcripts from all schools attended, including prerequisites (cumulative GPA of 3.0 preferred)
- two official letters of reference
- professional goal statement
- resume or CV
- writing sample (academic paper, clinical document or publication)
- for international students, TOEFL with a minimum score of 560 (paper-based), 230 (computer-based) or 88 (iBT)
