OVERVIEW

Earn your bachelor's degree in nursing in as little as 16 months with the Online RN to BS program from the University of Rochester School of Nursing. We offer credit for knowledge gained through past experience, and multiple options to complete the arts and science requirements. The part-time program will enhance your skills as a nurse and expand your career opportunities to work in a wide range of health care settings.

CURRICULUM

The Online RN to BS program offers a flexible curriculum, in which students will:

- develop an individualized degree plan with an advisor based on prior coursework and transferred credits (a maximum of 96 credits may be transferred)
- take 32 nursing credits covering nursing leadership, health care policy, pathophysiology and pharmacology, and population health, among others
- complete courses online with intensive advisement and technical support

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Associate's degree or diploma in nursing
- RN licensure within the United States or U.S. territory

OTHER PROGRAM OPTIONS

3+1 Inclusion program – Begin your nursing education at a Rochester area community college and complete the bachelor's degree at the UR School of Nursing.

RN to BS to MS program – If you're an associate or diploma-prepared nurse and want to become a nurse practitioner or educator, consider this program, which enables you to move more quickly through the coursework to earn your master's degree.

PROGRAM COST AND AID

- **\$1,200/credit hour** full tuition rate for the Online RN to BS program
- **\$600/credit hour** for nurses who live or work in the 18-county Western New York region with the guaranteed 50% Finger Lakes Regional Scholarship
- **\$540/credit hour** for nurses who work at a UR affiliate organization with the guaranteed 55% Affiliate Professional Development Grant
- **\$0/credit hour** for University of Rochester employees who are eligible for the School of Nursing Tuition Grant

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis with the opportunity to enroll in fall, spring or summer semesters.

ADMISSION CHECKLIST

To apply to the Online RN to BS program, applicants will need to submit the following:

- official transcripts from all schools attended (cumulative GPA of 3.0 preferred)
- resume/CV (preferred)
- for international students, TOEFL with a minimum score of 560 (paper-based), 230 (computer-based) or 88 (iBT)
- one letter of support from a supervisor (or from a faculty member if you have not yet graduated from your associate program)
