One-to-One Education

Private Educational Sessions

Meet with one of our Diabetes Educators for a general diabetes information and education session to begin to gain the necessary skills needed to manage your diabetes.

Ongoing support is only a phone call away and you can call us anytime with questions. We will follow up with you at three and six month intervals to check on your status and answer your questions.

Free Glucometers

Most glucometers can be obtained, at no charge, from the Diabetes Educator along with training on how to use them.

Starting on Insulin

If your physician has determined that it is time to start insulin, you can meet individually with a Diabetes Educator to learn about storage and administration of insulin, site selection, and more.

Insulin Pumps & CGM

Our educators are certified pump trainers and are available to assist you with insulin pump starts and ongoing pump support.

The following topics will be covered at your one-to-one appointment(s):

Food and Beyond

1. What to eat, carbs, protein, fats & more
2. Solving the serving size mystery
3. Sorting through labels (bring your own)
4. What to do with that glucometer - learn about pattern management.

Complications & Exercise

1. HGA1c—what is this? How did I get here?
2. The impact of illness on my blood sugar
3. Exercise basics, local options
4. The diabetes connection with our eyes, feet, kidneys, heart and more

Medications

Why do I need them? How do they work?

1. Hypoglycemia—recognize it and treat it
2. Advanced carbohydrate counting
3. Using your meter to your advantage
4. Do you have an emergency plan?

Continued Counseling

Additional follow-up education sessions are available with a Diabetes Educator.

Continuous Glucose Monitoring

- A screening test for patients to help evaluate current medications, identify low blood sugars and more.
- Real time glucose monitoring for those on insulin pumps.
