Ambulatory Services

Allergy, Immunology and Rheumatology (AIR) - Rochester area - Nurse Practitioner/Physician Assistant (242966)

FT position available, primarily days.

Exciting new opportunity for NP/PA in an ambulatory setting in the rapidly growing Allergy, Immunology and Rheumatology division. The role includes seeing a variety of patients with a focus on new and follow-up patients with allergic disorders. Patient education and coordination of services will be integral in this role. Requires certification in NYS as a NP/PA and national certification. Will consider motivated new NP graduates with RN experience. The APP will participate in the education of learners (students and new employees), using clinical learning experiences, knowledge sharing and skill training.

Dermatology - Fellowship - DNP Preferred - Family Nurse Practitioner (242633)

FT position available, primarily days, no weekends

The University of Rochester is seeking a motivated Family Nurse Practitioner interested in specializing in Dermatology to acquire the needed skills through Dermatology's Advanced Practice Practitioner training program. This wonderful opportunity will position the advanced practice provider (APP) to participate in a rich array of education opportunities and one on one teaching provided by our nationally recognized faculty. The successful candidate will work with our faculty mentors throughout this two-year program to assist the candidate in the acquisition of Dermatology clinical knowledge and patient care skills. Rotations in subspecialty clinics in Dermatology are provided to deepen the trainee's understanding of Dermatologic diseases and their treatment. As part of dermatology training NP program, trainees will have the opportunity to learn about clinical translational research. In the Dermatology Clinical Trials Unit, the trainees will learn fundamentals of the clinical research process and serve as sub-investigators to sponsored and investigator-initiated clinical trials. Candidates must demonstrate a high level of clinical competence in the coordination of care across the inpatient and outpatient setting, strong communication skills, and a focus upon patient centered care and patient/family satisfaction. Prior

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experience in the inpatient/outpatient management of Dermatology is useful but not required. Experience in the analysis of outcomes and quality data and patient satisfaction data is a plus. Must be NYS NP licensed. We are looking for an energetic, self-motivated individual with exceptional organizational skills to provide care to our challenging and diverse patient population. The position involves providing direct patient care in collaboration with nephrology attending physicians. The setting is expected to be the ambulatory CKD clinic. The role includes: Seeing patient independently in CKD clinic, alternating visits with an attending nephrologist Submitting billing as appropriate Monitoring laboratories and home blood pressure readings Adjusting medications as necessary. Preparing patients for End Stage Renal Disease, utilizing appropriate referrals Refilling medications on patients that you see. Triageing new referrals for urgency Returning patient phone calls The position requires certification in NYS as a Nurse Practitioner and National certification as an NP. Must have UPIN for Medicare Billing, or be eligible to apply.

Infectious Diseases (ID) - Inpatient - Nurse Practitioner/Physician Assistant (243040)

FT position, 40 hours per week

The inpatient ID APP will work primarily in collaboration with Infectious Disease APPs and physicians to manage a variety of infectious disease clinical issues in the inpatient setting on the ID APP Team. The APP will work collaboratively with ID physicians, fellows, and pharmacists as needed. The ideal candidate must be able to work both independently and as part of a team. The APP will participate in consultative care and management of inpatients with infectious disease problems with a primary focus on general ID and patients with psychosocial barriers to care compliance (ex: patient with IVDU, other substance abuse disorders, housing insecurity, etc.). The array of infectious etiologies is broad. Care is multidisciplinary and involves close communication and cooperation with primary hospital teams and various hospital specialists. The APP should be able to work autonomously, but this position also requires excellent triage skills to identify when to escalate care and closely collaborate with specialty trained Infectious Disease attendings at all stages of care (initial evaluation, follow-ups, and

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consults). The APP will also participate in clinical regular conferences and division sponsored professional practice (journal clubs, case conference, etc). Prior Infectious Disease experience is valued but not required. Requirements: Nurse Practitioner – at least a Master's Degree in Nursing; Active NYS licensure as a Registered Nurse and Nurse Practitioner in good standing; current national certification as a Nurse Practitioner (at start of program). Physician Assistant – completion of an AMA approved Physician Assistant program; Active NYS Physician Assistant licensure in good standing; current national certification as a Registered Physician Assistant.

Benign Hematology and Apheresis - Nurse Practitioner/Physician Assistant (241628)

Cardiac Catheterization & Electrophysiology Holding Area - Advanced Practice Provider (242749)

FT position – Monday –Friday, 10-hour Day shift.

The area of practice is in the cardiac catheterization/electrophysiology laboratory caring for both inpatients and outpatients. The patient population will include patients undergoing procedures in the cardiac catheterization and electrophysiology laboratory. This is a full-time day shift. There is no holiday, overnight or weekend requirements. The APP will provide comprehensive care to cardiology patients. Primary responsibility will be to care for patients before and after cardiology

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procedures including but not limited to coronary angiogram/angioplasty, right heart catheterizations, biopsies, complex structural heart procedures ablations, AICD, pacemaker, cardioversions and peripheral angiograms. The APP will obtain history and physical findings, initiate appropriate orders, admit/discharge border patients, discharge planning and communications, placing pre-procedure orders, care follow-up calls, radiation exposure follow-up, communicate with providers on and off service and continue to coordinate care throughout the hospital stay. The APP will be expected to manage peri-procedural complications as well including, but not limited to hematomas, retroperitoneal bleed, stroke, stent thrombosis, arrhythmias, cardiac arrest, vasovagal responses, contrast dye reaction, and respiratory distress. The APP will provide verbal and written educational support for patients and their support system. The APP will provide educational support, informal and formal, for the cardiac catheterization staff, affiliated units, cardiology fellows and referring physician offices. The APP will be actively involved with quality assurance issues. He/she will be accessible to patients and other health care providers in the event of a complication. The APP would be involved in quality improvement projects, departmental committees, student preceptorship and give in-service presentations at times. There may be other task responsibilities in the future as well.

The Inpatient Transplant Infectious Disease APP will work in collaboration with the Transplant Infectious Disease physicians and an existing Transplant Infectious Disease APP to manage a variety of infectious diseases, clinical issues in the inpatient and outpatient setting.
