

Strong Memorial Hospital Seasonal Respiratory Virus Report – week ending 28 May 2016

Report highlights: Winter and early Spring seasonal viruses are fleeting, with modest Flu B activity (4 cases) left of the major players. Low numbers of metapneumovirus, coronaviruses, parainfluenza 3, and respiratory adenovirus cases are shown in the graphs. Rhinovirus/Enterovirus numbers are steady.

Results from the Strong Memorial Hospital microbiology lab for the previous 8 weeks are shown graphically as described below. The graphs display several components of testing, including changes in positive test results and testing volume with time, and positive test results divided into relevant age groups. The example below describes the different features of the graphs. Graphs will only be shown in the report when there is recent activity (>2 cases in the current week, or >5 cases in a given week in the reporting period). Adenovirus reporting includes only respiratory sources.
