

Strong Memorial Hospital Seasonal Respiratory Virus Report – week ending 4 June 2016

Report highlights: Winter and early Spring seasonal virus detection was very low (Flu A and Flu B) or absent (RSV). Rhinovirus/Enterovirus numbers are steady. Increased parainfluenza 3 (13 cases) and respiratory adenovirus (7 cases) activity was detected this week.

Results from the Strong Memorial Hospital microbiology lab for the previous 8 weeks are shown graphically as described below. The graphs display several components of testing, including changes in positive test results and testing volume with time, and positive test results divided into relevant age groups. The example below describes the different features of the graphs. Graphs will only be shown in the report when there is recent activity (>2 cases in the current week, or >5 cases in a given week in the reporting period). Adenovirus reporting includes only respiratory sources.
