The TEG Thromboelastograph test has been added to the test menu of the UR Medicine Labs Hematology and Chemistry Laboratory. The TEG analyzer uses whole blood to measure all phases of hemostasis. There are two orderable tests: TEG and HTEG (Heparinized TEG). HTEG should be used for patients on heparin.

Sample requirement: 1 full NaCitrate (Blue Top) tube.

Test availability: Available at all times, 24/7.

Sample Stability Must be performed within 2 hrs. of collection.
