As of August 26, 2016 testing of Vitamin D by LCMS/MS returned to Strong Memorial Hospital Clinical Toxicology/Mass Spectrometry Laboratory.

The reference interval for the SMH Clinical Toxicology/Mass Spectrometry Vitamin D test is as follows:

SMH Reference Interval: 25-Hydroxyvitamin D₂ and D₃ by Tandem Mass Spectrometry, Serum

Deficiency Less than 20 ng/mL

Low risk of deficiency 20-29 ng/mL Adequate 30-60 ng/mL

Potentially harmful Greater than 60 ng/mL
