





WEEKLY SMH FLU SURVEILLANCE

RSV was detected in 10 of 405 specimens (2.46%).






SARS-CoV-2 was detected in 38 of 1247 specimens (3.05%).







WEEKLY COVID-19 SURVEILLANCE

SARS-CoV-2 was detected in 8 of 490 specimens (1.63%).







Week 46 - Week Ending Nov 15, 2025

For the week ending Nov 15, 194 respiratory patient specimens were submitted for Human Metapneumovirus (hMPV), Adenovirus (AdV), & Rhinovirus (RV) testing.

hMPV was detected in 1 of 194 specimens (0.52%). AdV was detected in 5 of 194 specimens (2.58%). RV was detected in 49 of 194 specimens (25.26%).
