


WEEKLY RESPIRATORY SURVEILLANCE

CDC REPORTING WEEK 03 - WEEK ENDING JAN. 18, 2020

For the week ending January 18, 1198 respiratory samples were submitted for Influenza A/B and RSV testing. Influenza A showed an increase to 119 samples for a 9.9% rate of positivity. RSV was detected in 117 samples for a 9.8% positivity, a decrease from the previous week. Influenza B detection also decreased to 135 showing a positivity rate of 11.3%. There were 81 samples submitted for metapneumovirus, adenovirus and rhinovirus testing. Metapneumovirus was detected in 6 of 81 samples for a 7.4% positivity. Rhinovirus was detected in 8 samples.


% POSITIVITY INFLUENZA A/B

% POSITIVITY RSV










PARAINFLUENZA 1-4
