

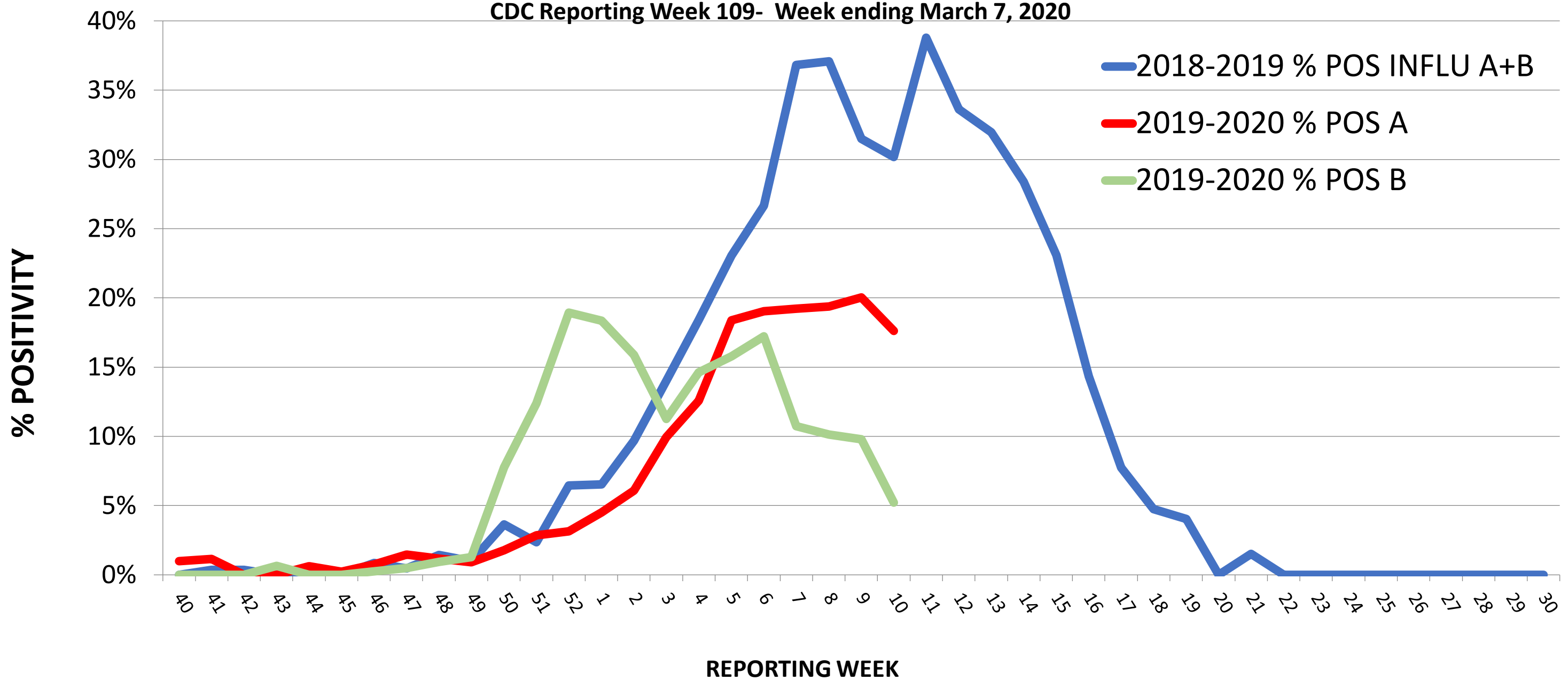
WEEKLY RESPIRATORY SURVEILLANCE

CDC REPORTING WEEK 10 - WEEK ENDING March 7, 2020

For the week ending February 29, 1308 respiratory samples were submitted for Influenza A/B and RSV testing. Influenza A decreased to 17.6% positivity. Influenza B detection decreased to a rate of 5.2%. RSV decreased to 2.8% positivity.

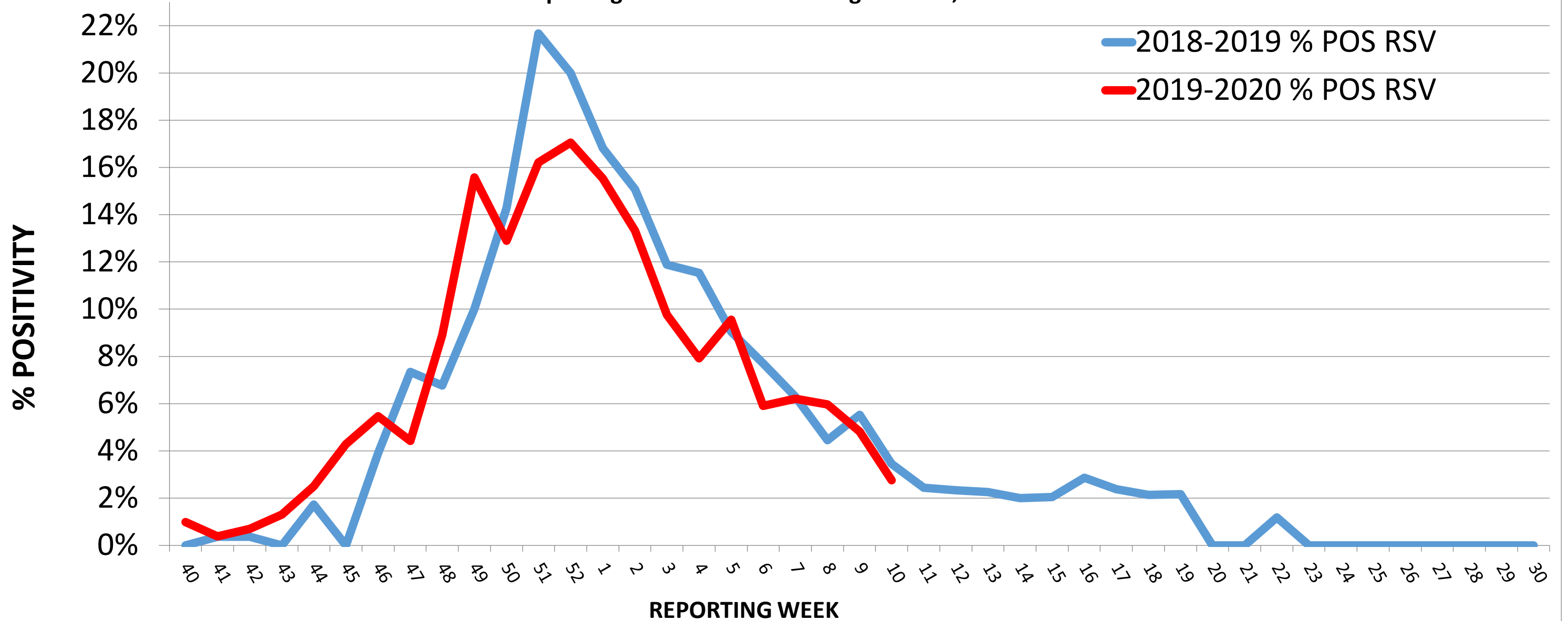
% POSITIVITY INFLUENZA A/B

% POSITIVITY RSV

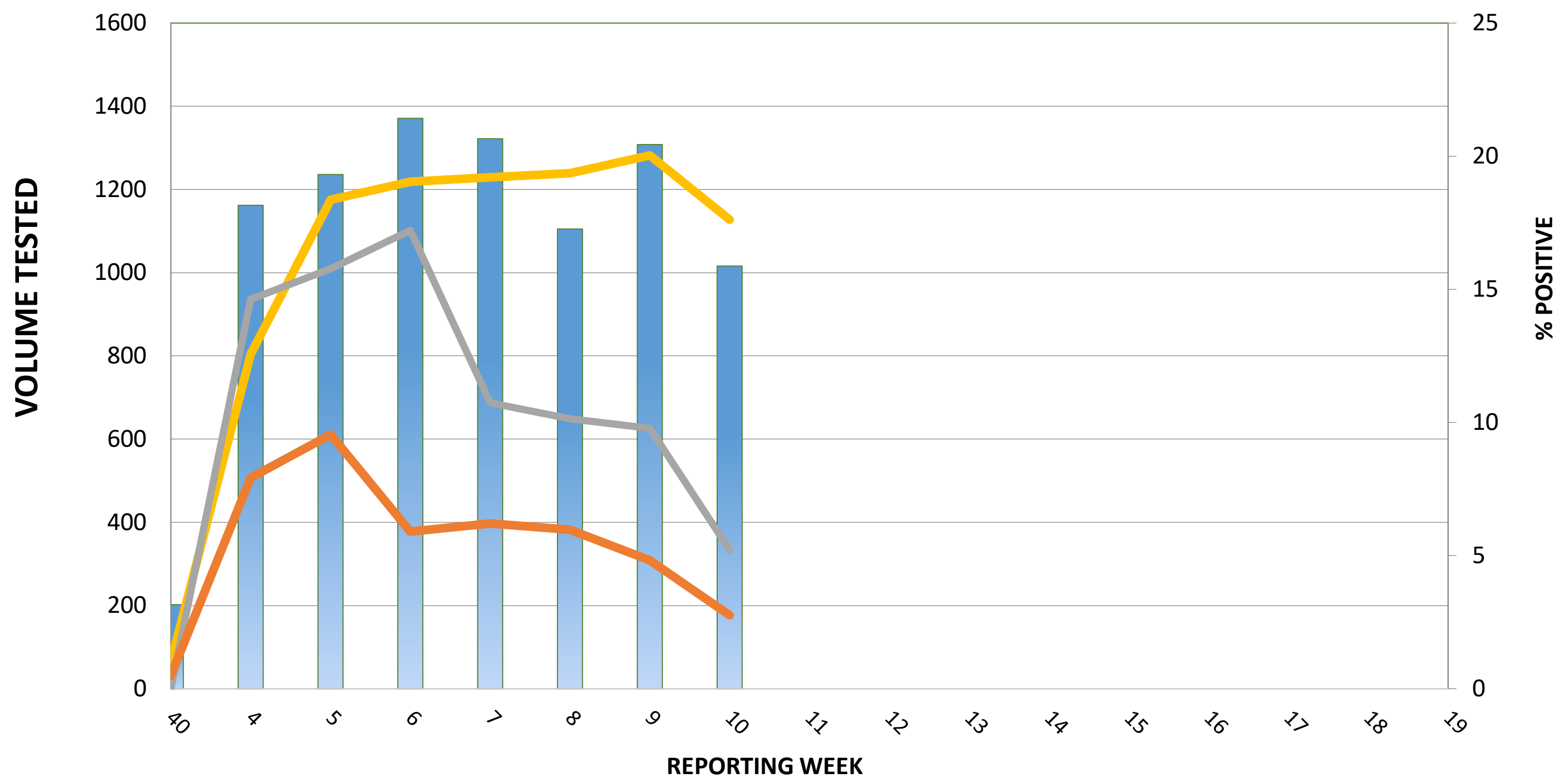

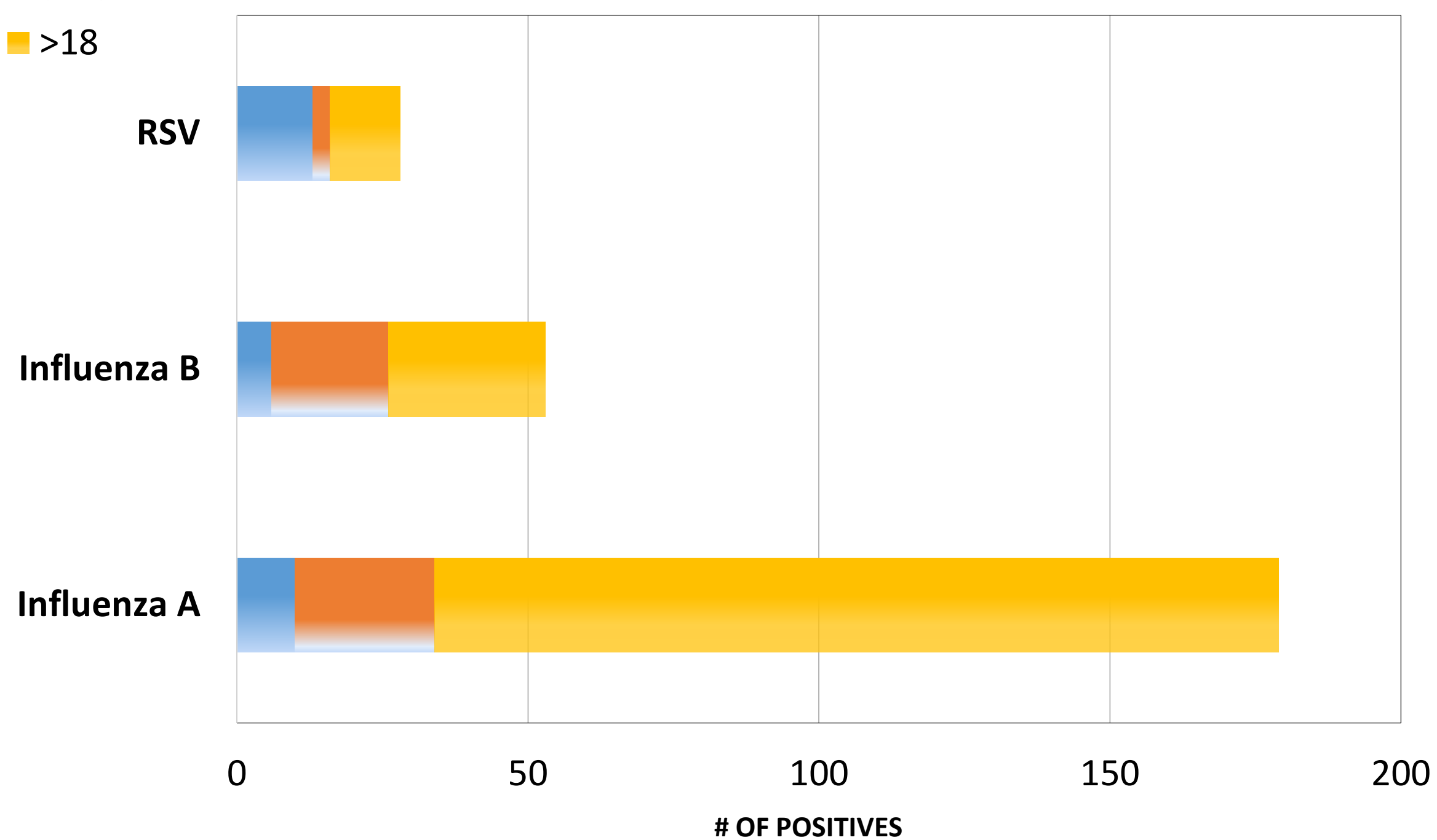

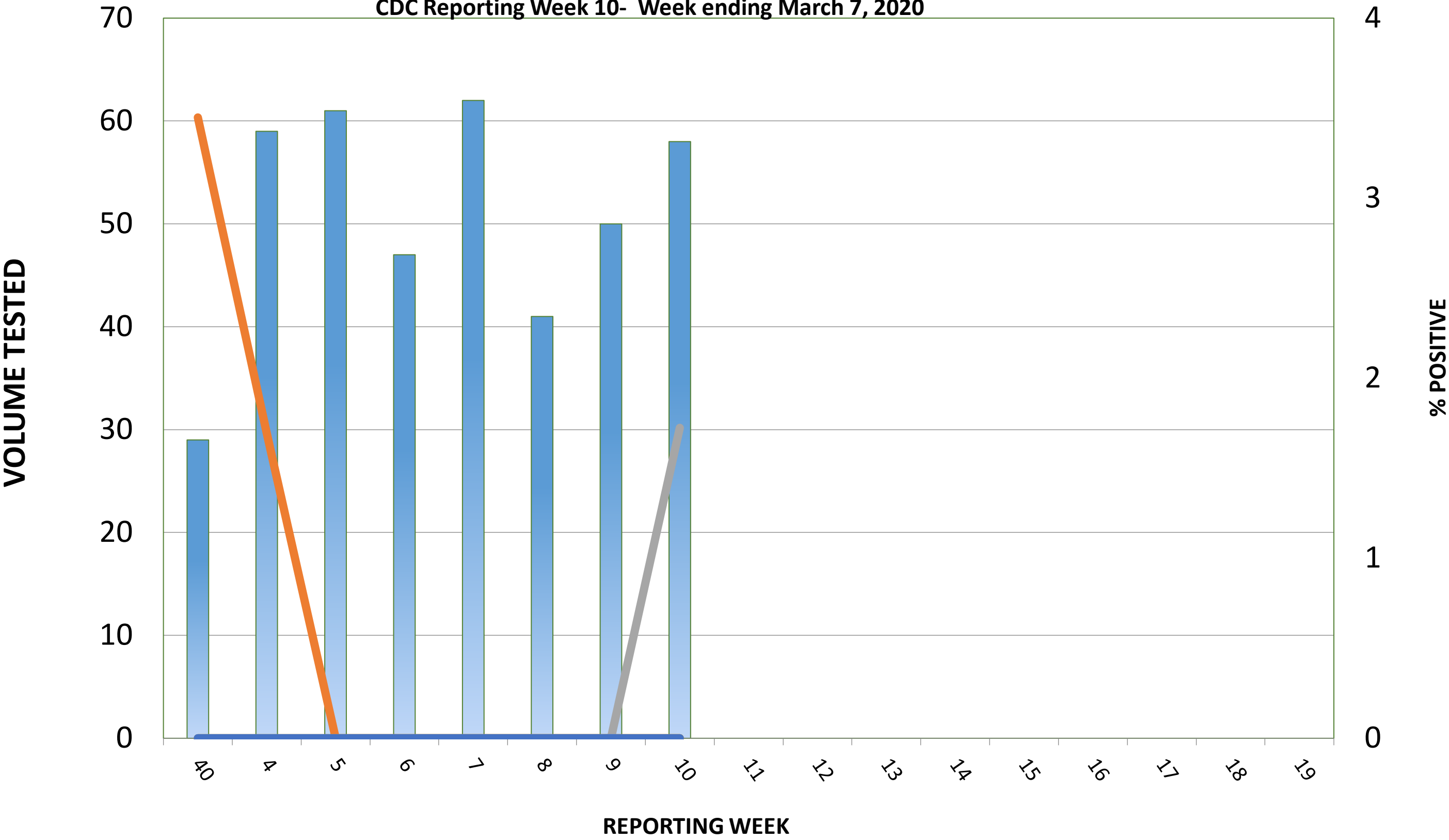
