



WEEKLY RESPIRATORY SURVEILLANCE

CDC REPORTING WEEK 50 - WEEK ENDING DEC. 14, 2019

For the week ending December 14, there were 566 respiratory samples submitted for Influenza A/B and RSV testing. RSV was detected in 73 samples for a 12.9% positivity. Influenza B had a sharp increase in detection this week with 44 samples showing a positivity rate of 7.8%. Influenza A was detected in 10 samples. There were 66 samples submitted for metapneumovirus, adenovirus and rhinovirus testing. Rhinovirus was detected in 13 of 66 samples for a 19.7% positivity.




INFLUENZA A, B and RSV







AGE (YRS):
