

UR Medicine Virology Laboratory Seasonal Respiratory Virus Report

Week ending 16 July 2016

Report highlights: Summer seasonal respiratory virus detection remained low this week with six new cases of Rhinovirus/Enterovirus and eight new cases of parainfluenza 3. Additionally, there were three new cases of adenovirus and a single case of metapneumovirus.

Results from the UR Medicine Virology lab for the previous 8 weeks are shown graphically as described below. The graphs display several components of testing, including changes in positive test results and testing volume with time, and positive test results divided into relevant age groups. The example below describes the different features of the graphs. Graphs will only be shown in the report when there is recent activity (>2 cases in the current week, or >5 cases in a given week in the reporting period). Adenovirus reporting includes only respiratory sources.
