

UR Medicine Virology Laboratory Seasonal Respiratory Virus Report – week ending 18 June 2016

Report highlights: Early summer seasonal respiratory virus detection was relatively low with Rhinovirus/Enterovirus cases slightly increased to fifteen cases as well as parainfluenza 3, which rose to eleven cases. There were four cases of metapneumovirus detected this week.

Results from the UR Medicine Virology lab for the previous 8 weeks are shown graphically as described below. The graphs display several components of testing, including changes in positive test results and testing volume with time, and positive test results divided into relevant age groups. The example below describes the different features of the graphs. Graphs will only be shown in the report when there is recent activity (>2 cases in the current week, or >5 cases in a given week in the reporting period). Adenovirus reporting includes only respiratory sources.
