

UR Medicine Virology Laboratory Seasonal Respiratory Virus Report

Week ending 22 October 2016

Report highlights: There were 19 new cases of Rhinovirus/Enterovirus. We have been seeing sporadic influenza A (1 case this week, at least 1 detected in each of the last 5 weeks) and RSV (2 cases this week), as well as sporadic parainfluenza and metapneumovirus (1 case each).

Results from the UR Medicine Virology lab for the previous 8 weeks are shown graphically as described below. The graphs display several components of testing, including changes in positive test results and testing volume with time, and positive test results divided into relevant age groups. The example below describes the different features of the graphs. Graphs will only be shown in the report when there is recent activity (2 or more cases in the current week, or >5 cases in a given week in the reporting period, *with an exception being made for influenza and respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) which will be graphed when any are detected*). Adenovirus reporting includes only respiratory sources.
