

# UR Medicine Virology Laboratory Seasonal Respiratory Virus Report

Week ending 30 July 2016

*Report highlights:* Summer seasonal respiratory virus detection remained low this week. There was, however, another surprise with an influenza A positive result (no graph shown). Last week we had one case of influenza B. Additionally, there were 11 new cases of rhino/enterovirus and 3 new cases of parainfluenza 3.

Results from the UR Medicine Virology lab for the previous 8 weeks are shown graphically as described below. The graphs display several components of testing, including changes in positive test results and testing volume with time, and positive test results divided into relevant age groups. The example below describes the different features of the graphs. Graphs will only be shown in the report when there is recent activity (>2 cases in the current week, or >5 cases in a given week in the reporting period). Adenovirus reporting includes only respiratory sources.
