

UR Medicine Virology Laboratory Seasonal Respiratory Virus Report

Week ending 13 May 2017

Report highlights: For the week ending May 13, 2017, 202 respiratory samples were submitted for testing. We had a slight uptick with 5 new cases of influenza B. There were no reports of RSV or influenza A. Rhinovirus/enterovirus was the major respiratory virus to appear in this week's report with 26 new cases along with 10 new cases of parainfluenza 3.

Results from the UR Medicine Virology lab for the previous 8 weeks are shown graphically as described below. The graphs display several components of testing, including changes in positive test results and testing volume with time, and positive test results divided into relevant age groups. The example below describes the different features of the graphs. Graphs will only be shown in the report when there is recent activity (2 or more cases in the current week, or >5 cases in a given week in the reporting period, an exception being made for influenza and respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) which will be graphed when any are detected). Adenovirus reporting includes only respiratory sources.
