

# UR Medicine Virology Laboratory Seasonal Respiratory Virus Report

Week ending 22 April 2017

**Report highlights:** For the week ending April 22, 2017, 320 respiratory samples were submitted for testing. Positivity for influenza A and B decreased to 4.7%. Only one new influenza A was reported along with only 14 new cases of influenza B. RSV positivity also decreased to 2.2% from the previous week with only 7 new cases. Rhinovirus/enterovirus was the only other respiratory virus to appear in this week's report with 18 new cases.

Results from the UR Medicine Virology lab for the previous 8 weeks are shown graphically as described below. The graphs display several components of testing, including changes in positive test results and testing volume with time, and positive test results divided into relevant age groups. The example below describes the different features of the graphs. Graphs will only be shown in the report when there is recent activity (2 or more cases in the current week, or >5 cases in a given week in the reporting period, an exception being made for influenza and respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) which will be graphed when any are detected). Adenovirus reporting includes only respiratory sources.
