## University of Rochester Diversity Scholarship Program:

The University of Rochester Department of Urology prides itself on the promotion of diversity, equity, and inclusion and is considered a top departmental priority. The Diversity Scholarship program encourages students of historically underrepresented groups to bring a diverse perspective to the program fostering an environment that appreciates and values diversity. Students must be in good academic standing at a LCME accredited medical school in the U.S., a U.S. citizen or permanent resident. Recipients would experience all that UR Medicine has to offer through visiting sub internship grant. Students must be attending an allopathic medical school in the U.S. to be eligible.

This scholarship awards \$2,000 in financial support to help offset the cost of a visiting sub internship.

All URMC Urology electives listed on VSAS are eligible for the program except the virtual electives. *Two week rotations will have reduced grant awards.* 

Applicants must commit to the elective if the award is accepted. There is a no-drop policy.

Awards will be given starting on May 10<sup>th</sup> on a rolling basis no later than 2 weeks after your application until all awards are distributed.
