### Preparing for your appointment

Arrival: Please come 15 minutes early.

What to bring: List of your medicines and any health-monitoring devices you use.

Cancellations: Notify us at least 24 hours in advance if you can't make it.

### **Prescription refills**

Refills: Make sure you have enough medication to last until your next visit.

Between Appointments: Contact your pharmacy for refills.

Refill Timing: No refills are processed after 4:30 p.m. on weekdays, including weekends and holidays.

Processing Time: Allow up to five (5) business days for routine and ongoing refill requests.





# **Onsite Services**

We offer many services at the Brighton Health Center, including mental health, chemical dependency treatment, care management, pharmacy, and lab.

#### **Mental Health Services**

The Strong Ties Clinic is a team-based outpatient mental health clinic that serves adults who are coping with issues related to severe and persistent mental illness.

Strong Recovery promotes recovery from addiction and co-occurring disorders (such as mental illness) through an integrated care model.
