They were not sure how common ventilator-dependent dialysis was needed and for this reason could not speak to the impact of the project.

Specifically for the project the stakeholder emphasized that this was a better setting for care for patients. For the community, there is insufficient nursing home availability.

Transporting patients for dialysis puts considerable stress on staff and the quality of care. The project has a strong positive impact by getting patients out of the hospital. They noted that dialysis and ventilator-dependent patients are very complex. It is important to provide care coordination for these very complex patients. As a general comment, the stakeholder said that Black and Hispanic families have difficulty in navigating the transition to nursing home care for their elders.
