Utility of a Neuropsychological Evaluation:

- Assess presence & nature of cognitive impairment
- · Provide differential diagnosis
- Determine baseline level that allows for comparison of cognitive functioning over time
- Explain the functional impact of brain dysfunction on everyday life
- Recommend appropriate treatment planning and individualized recommendations
