SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR SERVICES  
LEVELS OF VETERINARY CARE  
Effective July 1, 2013**

- LEVEL 1      No handling of the animal.  
(e.g. observe appetite, attitude, feces or urination)
- Charge: \$6.75 per level 1 visit
- LEVEL 2      Handle the animal and/or administer medication or treatment.  
(e.g. assess hydration, suture removal, trim teeth, administering drug that  
was provided by investigator and is easily given)
- Charge: \$8.50 per level 2 visit
- LEVEL 3      Any treatment that requires greater than 5 minutes  
Administration of any drug/fluids that are taken from DLAM pharmacy  
but not otherwise charged to investigator (e.g. administering antibiotics or  
subcutaneous fluids, tranquilizing and/or treating a monkey, compromised  
dog, etc.)
- Charge: \$50.00 per tech per hour (charged in 15 minute increments)
- 15 minutes of a level 3 is charged whenever an investigator euthanizes an animal on rounds without informing DLAM.
  - Levels of care should be written on clinical case or post-op records at the time that observations are made.
  - Consumable supplies used in treatment are charged to the investigator except drugs/fluids, which are included in level 3 charge.
