Dental and Oral Surgery Considerations for Medically Complex Patients

This is a series of lectures, presentations and grand rounds held weekly from September 20, 2012 through July 11, 2013, once every 2 weeks.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES:

Topics covered include dental management of patients with medically complex background (syncope, asthma, seizures, diabetes, bleeding disorders, hematology diseases, oncologic diseases, bisphosphonate treatment), pregnancy – do's and don'ts in dental management, microbiology of oral and maxillofacial infections and an update on antibiotics, fundamentals of implants, pearls and pitfalls in dento-alveolar surgery.

Hospital Dental Services within Strong Memorial Hospital encompasses oral surgery, oral medicine and hospital dentistry. The group provides an interdisciplinary diagnostic and treatment service for patients with complex orofacial needs.

Among the faculty, special orofacial surgery interests include cleft repair and reconstruction, dental implants, facial cosmetic surgery, management of facial deformities and facial injuries.

Oral medicine interests include diseases and lesions of the oral tissues, oral manifestations of systemic diseases; oral complications of cancer therapy and hyposalivation (dry mouth).

The general dentistry interests are with dental and periodontal health of patients prior to cardiac surgery and dental clearance prior to solid and hematopoietic stem cell transplantations.
