Important:

- 1. Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment to complete the following check-in process. Bring your insurance information and co-payment (if applicable) with you.
- 2. Allow a minimum of 3 hours to complete your examination and possible testing. Please note testing may require an additional copay depending on your insurance. Therefore, you may receive a bill from the hospital for testing.
- 3. Since your examination does include dilation of your eyes, we suggest that someone accompany you to drive you home and that you bring sunglasses.
- 4. Please complete the attached paperwork and bring it in with you the day of your appointment. Please do NOT mail this information, bring it with you to your appointment.
- 5. If you wear glasses, bring them with you (even if they are just for reading).
- 6. Ladies, please refrain from wearing any eye make-up or perfume. Gentlemen, please refrain from wearing any cologne of any kind.
- 7. If you are non-English speaking, either bring someone with you to translate or provide us advance notice to obtain a translator from the hospital.
- If you have laboratory tests performed for you current condition, bring the results with you or arrange to have your physician send them before your visit. If you have seen other physicians whose reports will be helpful, please have them sent as well.
- 9. A detailed report of your evaluation will be sent to your referring physician and primary physician. Please provide <u>the full name, complete address and phone</u> <u>number of all physicians</u> you would like us to correspond with.
- 10. All patients are scheduled to allow enough time for complete medical history, examination and discussion of their condition. If you are not able to keep your appointment, please notify our office as soon as possible, preferably 48 hours in advance.
- 11. If a physician referral is required for your health care plan, please contact your Primary Care Physician prior to your appointment to make sure that all the paperwork is completed.

Our office is located on the third floor of the Flaum Eye Institute at the University of Rochester Medical Center. A map and directions are enclosed. Free parking is available in the outdoor lot at 210 Crittenden Boulevard, at the Adeline P. Lutz Pavilion entrance of the Eye Institute.
