- Full time students typically complete the program in 6 terms.
(6 terms = 2 Years or 24 months. This would include two summer semesters.)
- Part time students can adjust their plan, taking approximately 4-5 years.
- All students will complete 15 credit hours of Clinical Practicum and need 500 clinical contact hours with at 100 hours of supervision.
