Promoting Values Considerations in Biomedical AI Development

This lecture will present findings of a study that tested the effect of a group design exercise on whether and how AI developers of biomedical products considered the impact of their work on others, using perspective-taking as a “values lever.” We used hypothetical scenarios that asked AI developers to take perspectives on others who would use or be affected by their product. We found that this brief group exercise can increase awareness of the impact of design considerations on a broad range of interest holders and inspire plans for action in future work.
