

ACE Inhibitors Enalapril (Vasotec) Lisinopril (Zestril, Prinivil)

Use:

- These medications are used to lower blood pressure. They may also be used to help a weak heart or help heart function after a heart attack.
- These medications can be taken with or without food.

Possible side effects you may experience include:

- Low blood pressure, dizziness, cough, diarrhea, headache.
- Signs of an allergic reaction, like rash; hives; itching; red, swollen, blistered, or
 peeling skin with or without fever; wheezing; tightness in the chest or throat;
 trouble breathing or talking; unusual hoarseness; or swelling of the mouth, face,
 lips, tongue, or throat.
- Please contact us or your PCP if you feel faint or dizzy, or you develop signs of an allergic reaction.
