Diuretics

Furosemide (Lasix), Bumetanide (Bumex), Torsemide (Demadex), Chlorothiazide (Diuril), Hydrochlorothiazide (HCTZ) <u>Use:</u>

- Diuretics are used to lower blood pressure or decrease swelling (edema).
- This drug is given by mouth and can be taken with food or milk.

Possible side effects you may experience include:

- Low blood pressure, dizziness, lightheadedness, headache, increased urination, itching, rash.
- This medication may cause you to have low potassium level, you may need potassium replacement.
- Take more time to move from lying down or sitting to standing up to make sure you are not dizzy or light headed and can walk safely without falling down.
- Please contact us or your PCP if you feel faint or dizzy.
