



University of Rochester Geriatric Assessment Clinic

The program was developed to address the long-term health concerns faced by older individuals and their families. The clinic features a Geriatric Health Care Team that thoroughly evaluates the health and functional ability of older adults by examination, interview of both patient and family, and by information from the primary care physician. The clinic is currently housed at Monroe Community Hospital.

Staff/Providers: University of Rochester Division of Geriatrics and Aging Faculty

Hours of Operation: Friday mornings 8 am - 12 pm. Initial patient appointments last approximately 3 hours. Patients return several weeks later for a one-hour long closure visit.

Services Included: Nursing, Medicine, Social Work, Neuropsychology, Pharmacy

Eligibility Requirements: 65 years or older, established with primary care physicians and not currently being seen by a geriatrician

Method of Payment Accepted: Most Insurances and Medicare

Documentation Required for Service: Must have an established primary care physician and a record request will be sent to that physician's office with patient consent prior to appointment for the team to review.

Instructions for Referrals: Our primary referral base is the Rochester area and Monroe County, but referrals are accepted from across the region. Call phone number to start intake process. Clinic nurse will return your call to complete intake assessment over the phone.

Waitlist/Availability: ~3 months, first priority given to Monroe County residents but will accept referrals from surrounding counties.

Languages in which the Service is Provided: English only, interpreter by request

Physical Accessibility/Proximity to Public Transportation: Easy access for wheelchairs and on bus route.
