The Health Behavior Survey-Sign Language Version (HBS-SLV) is an interactive computer based version of the Health Behavior Survey (HBS). The HBS-SLV is administered through the use of a flexible computerized user interface developed for the NCHDR through a collaboration between the Rochester Institute of Technology and the University of Rochester.

The user interface permits a survey participant to self-administer the HBS optionally in ASL, in English-based sign language, or in modified English text only, to select preferred sign models, and to choose the most comfortable background color and viewing size of video
