Abdominal Imaging Advanced Practice Provider, within the department of Imaging Sciences (251446)

The Abdominal Imaging Advanced Practice Provider (AI APP) is responsible for providing competent medical care in accordance with the professional scope of practice and current State of New York Regulatory Statues.
